




# PRESSING ISSUES AND PARTNER PRIORITIES\* MAJOR MIGRATORY MOVEMENTS INSIDE THE SUB-REGIONS

The densely populated sub-region of Southern Asia, encompassing 1.94 billion people (UN DESA, 2020) in nine countries – Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka - has been shaped by major migratory movements, both within the sub-region and

#### REFUGEES AND INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDP) AND LABOUR MIGRATION

As well as hosting significant populations of refugees and Internally Displaced Persons (IDP), it is also one of the most important regions of origin for international labour migrants, in particular to the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries. Pre-COVID-19, emigrants from Southern Asia had sent an estimated 20 per cent of all remittances globally to their countries of origin in 2019 (World Bank, 2020).

#### PRONE TO DISPLACEMENT DUE TO ENVIRONMENTAL DISASTERS

As the region contains some of the world's most disaster-prone countries, the number of people at risk of displacement due to environmental disasters is high.

# GLOSSARY

**ACTION**: Approved capacity development projects.

**EXPERT:** Skilled professionals engaged by MIEUX+ to drive forward the individual activities of each Action. These are mostly officials from EU Member States administrations and from administrations outside of the EU, academia and experts with key skills that cannot be found inside the public administrations.

### HORIZONTAL INTERVEN-

**TIONS:** Cross-cutting areas of migration governance, such as data management, human rights and policy development, that complement MIEUX+'s four thematic areas.

## PARTNER COUNTRIES:

Countries eligible for assistance under the **Development Cooperation** Instrument (DCI), European Development Fund (EDF). European Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI) and the Overseas Association Decision (OAD) with which MIEUX+ establishes cooperation and which are the beneficiaries of MIEUX+ Actions and activities.

#### THEMATIC AREAS: MIEUX+'s main thematic areas are legal migration, migration and development, irregular migration, and international protection and asylum. To these, horizontal interventions are added, e.g. all the interventions that cover more than one strand and are therefore cross-cutting, for instance human rights or
