

FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS



* The rights considered are excerpted from various international treaties, namely the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, the Convention on the Rights of the Child and its Optional Protocols, the International Convention on the Protection of the Rights of All Migrant Workers and Members of Their Families, the conventions relating to the Status of Refugees and Stateless, and the Convention against Transnational Organized Crime and its supplementary Protocols.

CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS

NON-REFOULEMENT

Prohibition of "non-refoulement" to country of origin where there are substantial grounds for believing that there is a real risk of irreparable harm to the child



SURVIVAL AND LIFE

Right to survival, life, and development



CHILD PROSTITUTION

Prohibition of the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography



IDENTITY

Right to preserve his or her identity, including nationality and name



ARREST

Arbitrary arrest, detention and deprivation of liberty



VIOLENCE

Prohibition and elimination of all forms of violence and exploitation, including use of children as soldiers, trafficking, sexual abuse, hazardous work, smuggling and harmful practices



ECONOMIC, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL RIGHTS

EARNINGS & SAVINGS

Right to transfer earnings, savings or other personal monetary assets abroad subject to domestic currency regulations



EDUCATION

Right to education, both formal and non-formal, especially for girls



STANDARD OF LIVING

Right to an adequate standard of living, particularly concerning nutrition, clothing and housing



PLAY

Right to recreation and play



HEALTH STANDARD

Right to enjoy the highest attainable standard of health and facilities for the treatment of illness and rehabilitation of health



MEDIA PROSECUTION

Prosecution of any forms from all types of media including social media, offending /stigmatising deliberately migrant children



TRADE UNIONS

Right to join trade unions and other organizations or associations of their choice and to participate in their activities.
