Since its inception in 2009, the MIgration EU expertise (MIEUX) Initiative has served as an invaluable and inclusive platform for requesting capacity development activities and EU expertise, fostering the exchange of knowledge and practices among peers in all areas of migration management and governance.

Operating across Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean, and the EU Neighbourhood, MIEUX has implemented 138 Actions in more than 100 countries. This has involved the support of 48 EU MS Focal Points to deploy 465 experts and reached over 15,000 participants.

Over the past 15 years, MIEUX has played a pivotal role in building bridges between the EU and partner countries by deepening the understanding of migration. It has brought together diverse stakeholders to formulate national and regional migration goals, supported the establishment of institutional cooperation frameworks, and empowered partners with tailor-made practices, solutions and policies.

The one-day closing event will bring together partners, experts and migration practitioners to recognise and celebrate the dynamic and impactful achievements of peer-to-peer exchange within the ever-evolving MIEUX Initiative, showcasing its impact.
